What is this competition all about?

We invite Youth around the world to take part in the 2023 UNESCO Worldwide Multimedia Competition. Think creatively, and answer the question,

Follow the steps below

- **1.Step A**: Pick one of the 17 Sustainable Development Goals.
- **2.**Step B: Develop a project related to the Sustainable Development Goal you choose. This includes writing out...
 - 1. What is your project? and why is it important?
 - 2. What are your project goals/objectives?
 - 3. Where will you do your project? For Example, You can do your project with your school, church, community, or organization.
 - 4. What is your time frame? (when you will start and complete your project?)
- **3.**<u>Step C:</u> Do your Project. Remember to take videos, pictures and document your results and the impact of your project, and anything you feel is important to share.
- **4.**<u>Step D:</u> Put it all together and send it to us. By clicking on the "Sumit" button below. Create a Video, Presentation, or Essay with Images sharing the answers to the above questions in step 2 with the results you achieved and anything else you feel is important to share.

Youth were encouraged to respond by making a 3-minute video, multimedia presentation, written essay, art work or using any method that channels their specific passion and talent to share their answer to the question.

- Encourage young minds to think about important issues facing our world today.
- Inspire youth to answer the question using their talents, creative thinking and problem solving skills.
- Bridge generations in the ideas, development and implementation of positive change.
- To facilitate collaboration and team work with project development and implementation.
- To strengthen the mission and goals of UNESCO including peace and international goodwill.















Why is it important?



Youth are in one of, if not the, greatest positions to effect change in the world. They have the greatest connection with their own generations.

It is important to empower youth to purposefully use their talents to serve others and to ensure positive impact of their works throughout their life. We wanted to create opportunity for youth to share their voice and turn ideas into action.













Time line of the Contest

- The contest starts January 6, 2023 and the final deadline is March 31, 2023. Judging will take place and final winners will be announced May 30, 2023.
- The competition was shared through news, websites, social media and networks.
- The competition was split into three age groups. Juniors ages 10-14; Youth ages 15-19; and Young Adult ages 20-24
- All judging was done online, being sensitive to schedules, time zones and cultures.
















What was the response?






Applications by Country






Applications by Country








Applications by Age




















Applications by Project Type


















